# HICKORY MIDDLE SCHOOL CHEERLEADING TRYOUT INFORMATION

Tryouts for the Hickory Middle School Cheerleading squad will be held in the HMS main gymnasium on <u>June 3-6</u>: (optional clinic on Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup> after school until 6:30 for \$25)

- Fifth grade students should be dropped off at the main entrance to HMS promptly at 3:45, no earlier. They should be dressed and ready for the clinics, as they will not have access to any lockers or the locker room. They will remain at the entrance until escorted into the gym.
- Sixth and seventh graders need to use their PE lockers and be dressed and ready in the gym by 3:45 daily.

Instructional clinics/tryouts

June 3, 4 and 5 until 5:30
Final Tryout selections

June 6 until 6:00 PM

(Please pick students up outside in the cul-de-sac **promptly** after practice.)

You will need the following for the cheer clinics:

- 1. A white t-shirt/tank with sports bra (a tryout number will be issued and you will be required to wear it with a white shirt each day)
- 2. Black shorts on the day of selections (color of your choice on the other days)
- 3. Laced tennis shoes and socks daily
- 4. Hair up in a ponytail
- 5. Bottle of water daily with your name written on it

Clinics and tryouts are **closed** to the public. Students MUST attend school on clinic and tryout days in order to participate. Parents are reminded that they need to wait outside the building during clinics and for pick-up.

**Tryout Session**, Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup> will also be closed. Parents should plan to pick their child up around 6:00, but no cheerleader will be dismissed until all tryouts and callbacks are completed. Results will be issued at that time via a letter and their tryout rubric.

### CRITERIA FOR TRYOUTS

In order to try out for cheerleading, students must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Student must maintain a 2.0 GPA.
- 2. Students must be in good standing in regards to attendance and behavior.
- 3. Each student must complete and return "Cheer TRYOUT Packet" on or before Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be a box in the front office at HMS for your packets.
- 4. The administration shall make the final decision regarding student participation in tryouts.
- 5. Physical on file prior to try-outs (physicals will be given at HMS on May 13<sup>th</sup>) \*\* Physicals must be dated after May 1, 2018. \*\*

#### Cheerleader Expectations

- 1. A HMS cheerleader is expected to show enthusiasm, good sportsmanship, leadership, showmanship, and good character.
- 2. A HMS cheerleader is expected to maintain a 2.0 GPA and proper conduct at all times.
- 3. A HMS cheerleader is expected to attend <u>all</u> cheering practices and games. They must be available to attend August camp, Monday through Thursday after-school practices, and all school games they are assigned. The season begins in August and ends in February. HMS cheering obligations must come before competitive cheer obligations or other activities. This is a team sport and the entire team counts!

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5. A HMS cheerleader is expected to meet the financial obligations of the squad. Although the school provides the use of the basic cheerleading uniform, the purchase of additional personal items will be necessary. Should a candidate make the cheerleading squad, the cheerleader must be prepared to pay the following before the end of this school year:

In addition, each cheerleader will need cheer shoes (specifics will be announced at cheer parent meeting), no-show socks, cheer jacket (ordered in August additional-\$50-\$60), black gloves, and clear rain poncho.
